**1. Title of proposed paper** (e.g., A framework for addressing recreational fisheries conflict in developing countries).

**2. Author list including nationalities and email for the lead author** (Joe Blow, Spain, Joe. [Blow@coldmail.com](mailto:Blow@coldmail.com) ; Betty Boop, Senegal; Oscar the Grouch, Iceland).

**3. The Session/Symposium** (e.g., Symposium 1: Understanding angler behaviour through human dimensions and economics research)

**4. Abstract - up to 300 words.** You are welcome to use or update the abstract that you provided for the WRFC8.

**5. Fit with conference theme** - Up to 5 sentences describing if and how the paper fits with the conference general theme of *Balancing Values – The Future of Recreational Fishing Around the World*. Feel free to review theme content at <http://wrfc8.com>.

Emails with the above information must be received by July 16, 2017 (start of the conference) to be considered for the special issue. If an author is invited to prepare a manuscript, papers must be received by September 24, 2017 - this date is **NOT** flexible. If unable to prepare a manuscript within that time frame, please do not submit an abstract.

The initial screening will evaluate the scientific quality of the abstract and fit with the conference theme. Invitation to prepare a paper does not guarantee publication; all papers will be subject to peer review by appropriate experts.
